DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

- [1] At the start of the investigation meeting, I spoke with counsel to encourage them to confer with their clients and one another in an effort to resolve Michael Ansett's employment relationship problem. We then adjourned for a time to allow that to take place.
- [2] After a while, counsel advised me that their clients had resolved the problem. The terms of that resolution were reduced to writing and signed by both parties. The parties agreed that the terms of the resolution should remain confidential.
- [3] By consent, the written terms of resolution become the orders of the Authority in this matter. I make a further order prohibiting the publication of any of those terms.
- [4] The constructive approach of the parties and counsel in their efforts to resolve this problem is appreciated.
