CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

Employment Relationship Problem

[1] Part way through the Authority's investigation meeting I suggested that the parties confer and try to settle the employment relationship problem. As a result a settlement was recorded and signed. I was satisfied that the employment relationship problem had been settled having regard to that document. Also, I have decided not to record the facts because a confidential settlement has been reached and the parties have requested the terms be prohibited from publication.

[2] By consent the terms of settlement become an order of the Authority.
