SECOND DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

Prohibition from publication

[1] In a determination dated 1 September 2021, pursuant to clause 10 (1) Schedule 2 of the Employment Relations Act 2000, the Authority issued an interim order to not publish the identity of GF's second representative.¹

[2] In a 5 October 2021 memorandum to the Authority, GF's second representative, Ashleigh Fechny, sought the interim non-publication order pertaining to her be rescinded. New Zealand Customs Service do not oppose Ms Fechny's request.

Findings

[3] I find that there is no practical reason to continue the interim non-publication order relating to Ms Fechny but remind the parties that a permanent order relating to the Applicant remains in place.

Outcome

[4] The interim non-publication order relating to GF's second representative, Ashleigh Fechny is rescinded.
