<b>CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY</b>		

[1] The applicant, Shane Hatcher, lodged both personal grievance and wage arrears claims with the Authority. During the investigation meeting the parties' discussed their differences. Those discussions have continued and this has resulted in the personal grievance, but not the arrears, being resolved.

[2] The parties ask I record their settlement as a consent determination. I accept and order the settlement, recorded in a separate memorandum held by the parties, be incorporated into this determination. Its terms, which remain confidential to the parties, have the status of and are enforceable as an order of the Authority.

[3] The arrears claim, which concerns holiday pay, remains and will be considered at a reconvened investigation meeting to be held in due course.
