

[4] There was no attendance on behalf of the respondent at the investigation meeting and in the circumstances as described above I proceeded to hear from Mr Henning.

Determination

[5] If there is no objection to the demand notice, it is prima facie evidence before the Authority that the respondent company owes Heather Morris the sum of \$1,100.23 being holiday pay under the Holidays Act 2003.

[6] Mr Henning confirmed that the amount set out in the demand notice has not been paid and remains outstanding.

[7] It is appropriate to make an order that Glenelg House Limited comply with the demand notice.

[8] I order Glenelg House Limited to pay to the Department of Labour for credit of Heather Morris the sum of \$1,100.23 gross being holiday pay under the Holidays Act 2003.

[9] The payment is to be made in full by Wednesday, 4 July 2007.

[10] I also order Glenelg House Limited to pay to the Department of Labour the sum of \$70 being reimbursement of the filing fee.
