DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY BY CONSENT

[1] Steven Johnson has raised a personal grievance with his former employer, Haines Suzuki Marine Limited, saying he was unjustifiably dismissed. The matter was filed in the Authority as an employment relationship problem.

[2] The parties have resolved the problem and asked the Authority to make an order by consent in respect of the associated settlement.

[3] I therefore make the following orders:

- (i) With reference to clause 10(2) of the Second Schedule of the [Employment Relations Act 2000](#) the publication of any or all of the contents of the settlement is prohibited, save that this order shall not be applied in a manner that compromises clause 4 of the settlement; and
- (ii) As further set out in the attachment to this determination.
