JUDGMENT OF JUDGE J C HOLDEN

[1] For reasons which I will give subsequently in writing, the Court makes a freezing order in terms of the amended draft orders filed which may now be sealed by the Registrar.

[2] I am satisfied that the requirements of the High Court Rules have been complied with and that this Court is empowered to issue this freezing order under s

190(3) of the [Employment Relations Act 2000](#).

[3] The freezing order will expire at 5 pm on Monday 9 October 2017. The matter will be called in open court at 10 am in the Employment Court at Auckland, courtroom 2.02, Level 2, 41 Federal Street, at which time the Court will expect the first and second respondents to appear and be represented, and be heard by the Court

on whether the freezing order is to be continued.

[4] A copy of this judgment is to be served on the respondents and Pabla Law at

the same time as the Court's sealed order.

[5] There is to be no wider distribution of these orders than to the parties and their representatives until the orders have been executed and at least until the review date of 9 October 2017 has passed.

[6] The Court recommends that the first and second respondents obtain legal advice and representation about these proceedings as soon as possible.
