**CONSENT DETERMINATION OF AUTHORITY**

1. This matter was set down for an investigation in Palmerston North on 5 December 2006.
2. During the investigation the parties advised that they had reached a full and final settlement, the terms of which included a request that the Authority record the settlement as a consent determination and that the applicant withdrew her claim against the second respondent and there is no issue arising as to costs.
3. They also asked that a prohibition of publication order be imposed on the other terms of settlement of service and confirm its veracity to any inquirer without adding further comment.

4. I accept the parties request and hereby determine that the parties' agreement (a copy of which is held by the Authority) is incorporated into this consent determination and its details

– other than those set out above – are prohibited from publication: Clause 10(2) of Schedule 2 of the Act applied.
