**CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY**

**Employment relationship problem**

[1] This is a matter filed in the Authority by the applicant about four days pay.

**The claim**

[2] The applicant is seeking the payment of four days wages. The respondent has accepted that four days payment of wages is due and that he is prepared to pay the outstanding amount. This agreement settled all the issues for the applicant.

[3] The hours and dates of work were discussed between the parties and the Authority. It was agreed that Mr Morris was employed by Mr Morriss. Mr Morris worked 9 hours on 5 September 2005, 11 hours on 6 September 2005, 11 hours on 7 September 2005 and 7 hours on 8 September 2005. It was agreed that his hourly rate was \$17 per hour. He is owed 38 hours at \$17 per hour, totalling \$646 wages (gross). Mr Morriss has agreed to pay this sum. The payment settles the matter for the applicant. There are no other issues.

[4] By consent I order Andrew Morriss to pay Douglas Morris the sum of \$646 (gross) wages.
