### CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

1. Following discussions held at my initiative the parties advised that they have successfully resolved all matters between themselves and requested the terms and conditions of settlement to be incorporated into a consent order of the Authority.
2. The parties have signed a confidential record of settlement.
3. By consent, the terms set out in the confidential record of settlement are also the orders of the Authority in this matter that apply within the Authority's jurisdiction and applying between the parties for any enforcement.
4. The parties have agreed that the terms of settlement will remain confidential to the parties. For the purpose of preserving the confidentiality, I make a further order, pursuant to Clause 10 of the Second Schedule to the Act, prohibiting the publication of all the contents of the terms of settlement.

5. In addition and to complete the closure of this matter I record that the Respondent produced evidence in documents and statements of the financial

position of the company. I prohibited the publication of the information to protect the privacy of the company for commercial reasons.

6. The Authority's investigation has been closed and the documents subject to prohibition of publication are sealed on the Authority's file.
