### FURTHER CONSENT JUDGMENT OF JUDGE M E PERKINS

[1] These proceedings involve a challenge to a determination of the Employment Relations Authority dated 8 May 2017.<sup>1</sup> The subsequent determination on costs dated 8 June 2017 has not been challenged.<sup>2</sup>

[2] Following an adjournment during the course of the hearing of this matter on 1 May 2018, the parties have now reached an agreement on all outstanding matters and sought a consent judgment recording the terms of their agreement, which they wish to remain confidential to the parties. The terms of the settlement agreement have been recorded in a separate consent judgment of the Court.

[3] By consent the determination of the Authority dated 8 May 2017 on this matter is set aside and the consent judgment, incorporating the agreed terms of settlement, stands in its place.

[4] I also make an order prohibiting the publication of the contents of that earlier judgment under cl 12(2) of sch 3 of the [Employment Relations Act 2000](#), unless enforcement of that consent judgment is required.
