**NON-PUBLICITY ORDER OF THE EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS
AUTHORITY**

Employment relationship problem

[1] The applicant has filed medical information in support of her claims and now seeks a non-publication order regarding her medical information. The respondent does not object to that application.

[2] I consider it appropriate to issue a non-publication order to prevent the applicant's personal and sensitive medical information being put into the public domain.

[3] There is no good reason for that material to be publicly available in the circumstances of this particular matter. I consider it is not in the public interest for

that material to be disseminated more widely than the Authority's investigation meeting.

[4] Accordingly, I make a permanent non-publication order under clause 10 of the Second Schedule of the Employment Relations Act 2000 prohibiting the publication of the medical information the applicant has included into the joint bundle of documents for use at the Authority's investigation meeting.
