DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

Employment relationship problem

[1] Ms Taylor seeks a compliance order requiring Ms Puha-Tirikatene to comply with a consent determination dated 28 May 2018.

[2] The consent determination is subject to an order of non-publication and that order extends to this determination.

[3] Ms Taylor says Ms Puha-Tirikatene has not made the payments she agreed to make in the terms of agreed settlement, which became part of the consent order.

[4] I have seen evidence from a third party that confirms this is the case. I also gave Ms Puha-Tirikatene an opportunity to respond to the allegation that she had not complied with the terms of settlement but Ms Puha-Tirikatene has not submitted any information to me in the timeframe directed.

[5] On this basis, I am satisfied that an order for compliance is appropriate. I

order Ms Puha-Tirikatene to comply with the consent determination dated 28 May

2018. Ms Puha-Tirikatene must put in place the automatic payments, which are set out in the agreed terms of settlement attached to the consent determination, and she must continue to make the required payments until she has paid the agreed amounts in full.
