CONSENT DETERMINATION OF AUTHORITY

1. During an investigation into the parties' employment relationship problem they advised they had settled the matter on their own terms. A copy of their settlement was provided to the Authority. The parties asked the Authority to incorporate those terms into a consent order determination and, except for a public statement, to prohibit publication of its confidential details. I agreed with both requests: the parties' agreement (the original of which is held by the Authority) is incorporated into this

consent determination and its details are prohibited from publication: Clause 10(2) of Schedule 2 of the Act applied.

2. The parties are to be commended for this outcome.
