

[2] The Authority did not make an order for permanent non-publication of the names of ZUW and its director. It made an interim non-publication order for a period of 28 days to enable a challenge to the Employment Court.

[3] The Authority recorded in its determination that at the end of the 28-day period the interim non-publication order will lapse if there has not been a challenge to the Authority determination and/or a further order of the Authority or Court.

[4] On 19 June 2024 the Authority received a memorandum of counsel for ZUW attaching a statement of claim filed at the Employment Court. The statement of claim provides that there is a challenge by ZUW to the non-publication aspects of the determination.

[5] Mr Abdollahi seeks an order that the interim non-publication order made in the Authority's substantive determination does not lapse by the ending of the 28-day period.

Order

[6] There is a challenge to the Authority determination in respect of the finding that there should not be permanent non-publication of the names of ZUW and its director. The interim order for non-publication of the name of ZUW and its director is extended in the circumstances until further order of the Employment Court.
