#### CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

[1] In the course of the Authority's investigation, the parties have reached agreement as to how Mr Wang's employment relationship problem is to be resolved. They have asked the Authority to record their settlement as a consent determination. Accordingly, this consent determination contains the orders of the Authority.

[2] Daisys Agriculture Limited is Mr Wang's former employer and owes him

\$6,232 net in unpaid wages.

[3] James Hague representing Daisys Agriculture Limited is to pay Di (also known as Alan) Wang:

- \$1,000 per fortnight starting on Friday, 18 April 2014 and continuing every fortnight up to and including Friday, 13 June 2014, and
- One payment of \$1,303.56 on Friday, 27 June 2014 being the final payment of wages owed of \$1,232 plus \$71.56 that Mr Wang has paid to lodge this claim with the Authority.
