### JUDGMENT (NO 2) OF JUDGE K G SMITH

[1] On 9 August 2022, an order was made pursuant to [s 190](#) of the [Employment Relations Act 2000](#) freezing certain assets arising from any sale of the respondent,

Panda Restaurant Ltd.<sup>1</sup>

[2] On 1 August 2024, the applicant requested that the freezing order be discharged and that the proceeding be discontinued. The basis for those requests was that the parties have settled bringing to an end all matters between them including any issue about costs.
